## What We're Learning!

### Reading:

**Genre:** nonfiction, fantasy

**Comprehension Skills:** main idea and key details, point of view, sequencing

**Grammar:** see vs. saw

**Structural Analysis:** compound words

**Phonics:** multi syllable words (**see reverse side**)

**Trick Words:** people, month, Mr. Mrs.

### Math: number sense and place value:

count forward and backward by 1s, 5s, and 10s from a variety of starting points, read and write numbers 0-120, and add and subtract one and two digit numbers from two digit numbers.
