#### **Reading:**

Genre: folktale, poetry

Comprehension Skills: sequencing

Grammar: go vs do

Structural Analysis: open syllables

Phonics: long vowels spelled VCE-vowel

Trick Words: friend, other, another

Math: place value building and counting numbers with base ten blocks and craft sticks, using base ten blocks to add equations with double digits

### **Suggestions For This Week:**


#### Reading/Writing:
