What We're Learning!

Reading:

Genre: nonfiction, biography

Comprehension Skills: characters, setting, and key events, main idea and key details, and retelling stories

Grammar: nouns, verbs

Structural Analysis: complete sentences

Phonics: glued sounds (see reverse side)

Trick Words: put, two

Math:

count forward and backward by 5s and 10s, building and recognizing numbers by tens and ones, adding and subtracting by 1s, 5s, and 10s.

Class News

- We are starting to wind down our theme of "Our Community". We are also continuing to read and write words with the glued sounds "ang" as in fang, "ing" as in ring, "ong" as in song, and "ung" as in lung.. We will also learn four more glued sounds: "ank" as in bank, "ink" as in pink, "onk" as in honk, and "unk" as in junk.
- Be on the lookout for an email to sign up to come into the classroom dressed a the "community worker" you and share a 15 minute presentation about your job and how it helps the community.
- In math, we are continuing to develop the children's conceptual understanding of our number system through exploration of open and closed number lines, specifically, skip jumping along the number line by 5s and 10s forwards and backwards. This tool helps develop and build their confidence in adding and subtracting in multiples of 5s and 10s both on and off a "friendly 10".
- It's hard to believe, but it's almost the 100th Day of school!

 Day of School Project and the 100th Day Museum.

- Read a story to yourself and then retell the story to your family.


Math

- ☐ Engage in the attached math practice


Other/SEL
