What We're Learning!

Reading:

Genre: nonfiction and realistic fiction

Comprehension Skills: character, setting, and event and make and confirm predictions

Grammar: statements, questions, and exclamations

Phonics: short vowels, digraphs, bonus letters, and the glued sound "all" (see reverse side)

Trick Words: was, one, said

Math:

<u>Single Digit Sums</u> create, discuss, and utilize single digit number facts, double facts, fact families, and even and odd numbers to help solve equations

Class News

- In ELA, we will be starting our new theme: "Our Community". We will be reading and writing about jobs in our community. We will also continue to read and write words with short vowels, digraphs, and "bonus letters" (ff, II, ss) as in cuff, mess, and shell) and the glued sound "all" as in ball.
- In math, we are beginning our new unit: Adding, Subtracting, Counting and Comparing. In this unit, mastery of key number facts and fact strategies for single digit addition and subtraction is encouraged. Over the next few weeks, we will be using number racks to see number combinations, solve for the sum of two numbers, and compare two numbers to find the difference between them. In addition, we will also focus on developing place value understanding (tens and ones) and solve equations to 20.

- ☐ Write a list on community workers from the town of Upton


Math
