week we'll be focusing on addition and subtraction facts. The number rack tool will be used to help the children recognize combinations, to find the sum, to subitize, and to find the difference between two numbers.

- In ELA, we will be starting our new theme: "Our Community". We will be reading and writing about buildings in our community and what they are made of. In addition, we will focus on the the glued sounds "all" as in ball, "am" as in Sam, and "an" as in ran, as well as review/practice previously taught sounds and spellings.
- In math, we are continuing to engage in our unit: Adding, Subtracting, Counting and Comparing. This week, we will focus on putting together "10 and some more" to make the numbers 11 to 20. They will build place value understandings and use the "Make Ten" strategy to become more efficient at solving addition combinations to 20.

#### Reading/Writing:


- Practice reading the words, trick words, and sentences on the reverse side.
