What We're Learning!

Reading:

Genre: fiction and nonfiction

Comprehension Skills: make and confirm predictions and character, setting, and events

Grammar: statements, questions, and exclamations

Phonics: short vowels and digraphs (see reverse side)

Trick Words: we, he, she, be, me, for, or

Math:

Numbers: share, discuss, and utilize addition and subtracting strategies such as counting on or back, combining small groups, double facts, and working from known facts

- In ELA, we are wrapping up our theme of "Getting to Know Us", and we'll will write a personal narrative We will also continue reading and writing words with short vowels and digraphs (wh, ch, sh, th, and ck).
- This week in math, we will be developing and strengthening our addition and subtraction strategies. These strategies include knowing and using double facts, counting on from the largest number, counting back, and knowing facts from memory within combinations of 12.
