What We're Learning!

<u>Reading:</u>

Genre: Nonfiction and Realistic Fiction Comprehension Skills: ask and answer questions and main idea and key details Grammar: writing sentences beginning with a capital letter, a finger space between each word, and a punctuation mark at the end of the sentence.

Phonics: practicing identifying letters and their sounds and writing letters using the correct writing lines

Trick Words: see reverse side

<u>Numbers:</u> writing and identifying numbers, recognizing and creating number sets, counting patterns (2s and 5s)
