What We're Learning!

<u>Reading:</u>

Genre: Nonfiction and Fantasy **Comprehension Skills:** ask and answer questions and main idea and key details **Grammar:** writing sentences beginning with a capital letter, a finger space between each word, and a punctuation mark at the end of the sentence.

Phonics: practicing identifying letters and their sounds and writing letters using the correct writing lines

Trick Words: see reverse side

<u>Math:</u>

Numbers: recognizing, explaining, and creating number sets, grouping objects, solving for the whole (the sum) or a part of a given total

- Last week, Mrs. Bell shared the dates and times for Open House in her Memorial School Newsletter. I also sent a note on Friday on green paper about Open House. I look forward to meeting everyone at Open House!
- In ELA, we are continuing our review of the kindergarten sight words/high frequency words, letters and sounds, and how to properly write capital and lowercase letters using the correct writing lines. We are continuing our new theme-"Getting to Know Us". This week we will be reading and writing about what it's like to live in the country and in the city.
- In Math, the students are engaging in subitizing within 10 activities where they recognize the quantity of objects in a set without having to count each object individually. They are also exploring part-part-whole relationships within 20. This includes finding the total or sum of two groups, or finding an unknown part of a whole group.
